The \$15M project included replacing 4,500 feet of 36-inch concrete sewer pipe with a 48-inch fiberglass reinforced pipeline in the Tualatin Hills Nature Park. Included a trenchless crossing of trimet's MAX rail-line. The project incorporated significant environmental enhancements to the Beaverton and Cedar Mill creeks, and boardwalks throughout the nature park. Clean Water Services worked with Tualatin Hills Park & Recreation District, Washington County, Regulatory agencies, park stakeholders, and community organizations.
