In 2004 he championed APWA's accreditation of Eugene Public Works, one of the first public agencies in the nation to earn this recognition. He was a great leader and friend who exemplified the public works profession through his dedication to the community and a deep sense of caring for his employees. Simply put, Kurt made a difference - to his community, his colleagues, and his friends.

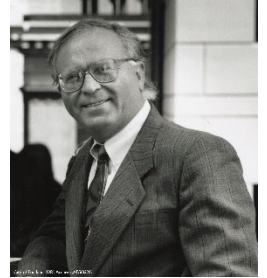
## Civil Engineering / Geomatics / Geotechnical Scholarship
